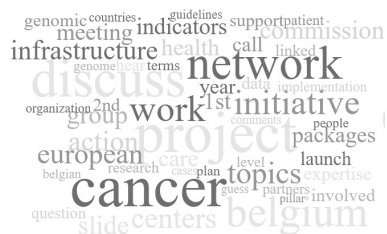

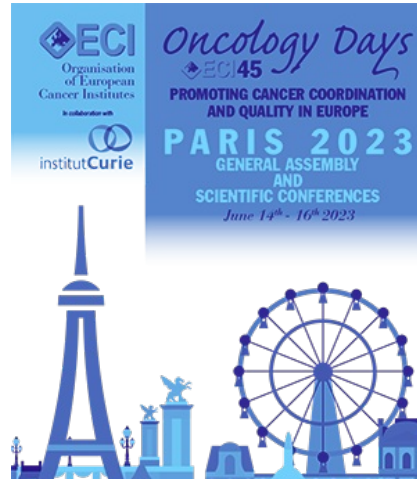
News

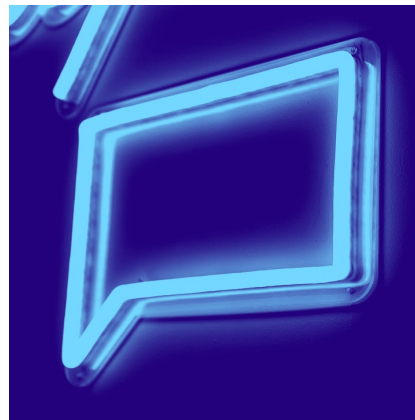

CanScreen-ECIS

Full title: Strengthening Cancer Screening data collection to update European Cancer Information System and improve quality and coverage of cancer screening programmes in Europe

Main areas: **EARLY DETECTION & SCREENING**

Timeline: 01/09/2022 - 31/03/2024 (18 months)

- The Scientific Advisory Committee has been established, chaired by Prof. Joakim Dillner (Karolinska Institutet, Sweden). It includes recognised cancer screening experts to review and validate cancer screening data submitted by different data providers, and to participate in scientific deliberations at different workshops.
- The Belgian Cancer Registry is selected to be part of this supporting committee.

Timeline: 01/05/2023 - 01/05/2026 (3 years)

- 9th December: Proposal was positively evaluated and received a grant
- The primary aim of ECHoS is to support the implementation of the Cancer Mission activities in all member states and associated countries through the establishment and development of Cancer Mission Hubs operating at national, regional and local levels.

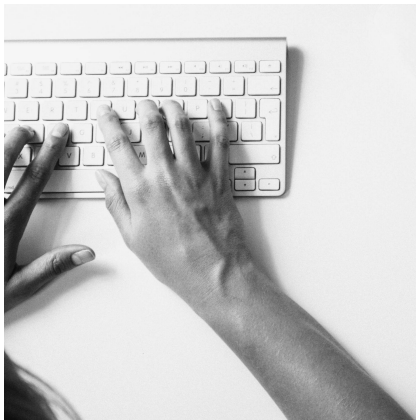
