The meeting brought together the partners of the project and was populated with interesting presentations, lively discussions, and food for thought. The meeting included keynote presentations from representatives from the European Commission and the European Parliament presenting the European strategy and vision on cancer care and research. Thereafter, round table discussions on different synergies and multistakeholder engagement took place to support cancer research. Finally, the partners presented the planned tasks and activities.  This new project coordinated by the Organisation of European Cancer Institutes (OECI) is funded by the Research and innovation actions supporting the implementation of the Mission on Cancer (HORIZON Europe programme). This Coordination and Support Action (CSA) will support Member States and Associated Countries in improving or developing their existing or future Comprehensive Cancer Centres, focussing on building their research innovation and digital-related capacities and their integration with cancer care. The CCI4EU objective is to achieve that 90% of cancer patients are treated in COmprehensive Cancer Centres by 2030.
The CCI4EU project kicked-off on 22-23 May 2023 in Milan.

Extended scope and new name for the thematic working group "Paediatric cancer"

The TWG on paediatric cancers has been launched in line with the European Beating Cancer Plan (EBCP) which 'put childhood cancer under the spotlight to ensure that children have access to rapid and optimal detection, diagnosis, treatment and care'. This initiative has been extended to adolescents and young adults with cancers to address their specific issues and unmet needs and 'to boost the transformation of paediatric cancer care'.

Therefore we propose to extend the scope of the existing TWG initially dedicated to children and adolescents to the population of young adults with cancers. And we invite people working in the field of AYA oncology / hematology to join this TWG renamed 'Children, adolescents and young adults (CAYAs) with cancers'.
